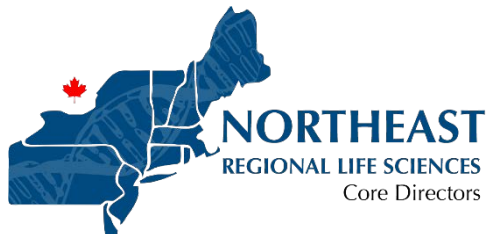




NERLSCD20 – October 27-30,
